

CAPE FLATTERY BUS TOUR
FRIDAY MAY 13, 2011 - SATURDAY, MAY 14, 2011.

This two day trip consists of a scenic bus tour through the Olympic National Park, past Crescent Lake to Clallam Bay and on to the Makah Museum and lunch. In the afternoon we will participate in a modest hike* to the point at Cape Flattery and then return to the Quality Inn for the evening. For day two we have a tour of the Port Angeles City Museum planned from 10 to 11 am. The museum is situated about 1½ blocks from our motel. This will allow you a little less than two hours to check out and return to the Coho for passage back to Victoria in the early afternoon.

* The trail took me about 20 minutes at an easy pace. About one third is fairly level and the balance mostly downhill on well-kept board walks. (this part of the trip is not suitable for those with walking difficulties)

If you would like to participate in this interesting tour, the cost would be \$76 payable to me as soon as possible, plus the self-pay costs noted above. Also it will be necessary for you to make a reservation with the Quality Inn (360 457 9434) as soon as possible. The cost for a 1 queen or 2 double bed unit is \$85.44. The cost for a 1 king or 2 queen unit is \$95.37 (both include taxes). A light breakfast is also included in the cost. You will require a passport in order to enter the U.S.A. and I must hand in a list of all participants to the American Immigration well before we leave on the Victoria Express.

This trip is limited to 24 persons and will not run with less than 20.
